

Sustainability Initiatives

DESIGN



Blue Orchid considers all aspects of design including materials and fabrication together with the most efficient use of plant and machinery and incorporates renewable and reusable energy. Examples of such include the solar panel system at Tower Suites which allows for reuse of up to 80% of the hotel's water consumption, and the removal of gas from Tower Residences with all Residences benefiting of the hotel's water consumption, together with the removal of gas from Tower Residences to more sustainable sources.

PROCUREMENT



Blue Orchid's procurement process follows the Triple Bottom Line - People, Profit, Planet. This incorporates a full B -C experience from supplier employment / labour practices - equality, diversity, employee well-being, education and development; transportation through shipping or air freight to the use of electric and hybrid vehicles; using local suppliers and those operating more sustainable systems and processes for packaging. The company's fleet of vehicles are all hybrid. It has recently invested in e-cargo bikes to transport smaller items between hotels in support of Blue Orchid's sustainable initiatives.

ENERGY
